# **Songwords and Extension Activities**

**Props Needed: An instrument each** 

# 1. Merry Music Go Round

(Tune of: Pop goes the weasel)
Merry, Merry Music Go Round
Merry, Merry Music
Sing and dance and play your sound
Let's make some music!

#### Action:

Clap your hands in time to the music, keeping a steady pulse.

## 2. Wave Hello

Wave Hello –Hello!

## 3. Incy Wincy Spider

Incy wincy spider, climbed up the water spout (make climbing spider with fingers)

Down came the rain, and washed poor Incy out (wiggle fingers to make it rain)

Out came the sunshine, and dried up all the rain (make a big, round sunshine)

And Incy wincy spider, climbed up the spout again (make climbing spider with fingers)

Copy the actions on the video and sing the song together.

# **Action Song: Standing up**

# 4. 5 Little Speckled Frogs

5 little speckled frogs
Sat on a speckled log
Eating some most delicious grubs – yum yum!
One jumped into the pool
Where it was nice and cool
Then there were 4 green speckled frogs
Glub glub!

**Verse 2:...**4 little speckled frogs... **Verse 3:...**3 little speckled frogs...

(hold up 5 fingers)
(squat like a frog)
(pretend to eat, and then rub tummy)
(jump like a frog)
(swim around)
(hold up 4 fingers)

**Verse 4**:...2 little speckled frogs... (faster) **Verse 4**:...1 little speckled frog... (faster)

#### Action:

Copy the actions on the video together, counting your fingers each time the number of frogs changes. There are quite a lot of actions here – encourage the children to join in with as many as they can! **Extension Activity:** 

Sing the song after the video, choosing 5 children at a time to be the frogs. Everyone stands in a big circle and sings the song together, with the frogs taking turns to jump into the pool (one frog per verse). Choose an order for the frogs to jump in, and let the children know who will go first, second, third etc. It helps to remind younger children whose turn it is before singing the next verse. They love this one!

(tap hands on the floor)

# 5. Can You Make a Rainy Sound?

Can you make a rainy sound? A rainy sound, a rainy sound Can you make a rainy sound? Make it with me now it.

V2: quietly V3: loudly V4: normally

### Action:

Pretend to make a rainy sound, by tapping to the pulse on the floor. Encourage the children to sing this simple song.

# **Action Song: Standing up dancing to Ocean Drum**

### 6. Dance Dance Dance

Dance dance dance til the music stops Dance dance dance til the music stops Dance dance dance til the music stops Then stand still! Stop!

V2: cheep, cheep til the music stops
V3: wiggle, wiggle, wiggle til the music stops
V6: skip, skip, skip til the music stops

V4: hop, hop, hop til the music stops V7: dance, dance, dance til the music stops

#### Action:

Join in with the actions on the video and sing the song together.

### **Extension Activity:**

How many more verses can the children create? What other actions can they link to springtime – either to do with animals or plants and flowers growing? Ask each child to think of a new action and create their own verse.

#### **Further extension:**

Ask the children to find something to tap or shake, and take turns to lead the group by playing along for their friends and being the conductor – keeping in time and telling their friends when to stop.

V2:...See the little birds all sleeping...flap little birds, flap, flap, V3:...See the little frogs all sleeping...jump little frogs, jump, jump

### **Action:**

Join in with the actions on the video and sing the song together.

### **Extension Activity:**

Which other animals can the children think of related to springtime to sing about?

Play your instruments together, stopping at the end of each verse. Children listen carefully to the video to see how they will play in the next verse, copying the speed and dynamic (volume).
