Songwords and Extension Activities

Props Needed: An instrument each
A scarf to wave

(Tune of: Pop goes the weasel)

Sing and dance and play your sound

Action:

Clap your hands in time to the music, keeping a steady pulse.

V2: the wipers on the bus go swish, swish, swish

V3: the horn on the bus goes beep, beep, beep

V4: the conductor on the bus says 'tickets please'

V5: the doors on the bus go open and shut

Action:

Copy the actions on the video and sing the song together.

Action Song: Standing up

(walk to the music)

(pretend to bandage)

I am a nurse, can you see?

Will you come to work with me?

Giving injections to make us strong

Looking after patients, all day long

V4:

I am a policeman can you see?

Will you come to work with me?

Driving the police car, singing our song

Keeping people safe, all day long

Action:

Copy the actions on the video and sing the song together.

Extension Activity:

Which other 'people who help us' can the children think of? Can they think of actions to show you what these people do in their jobs? Encourage them to think of new verses and actions, and share these with their friends.

V7 Dance, dance, dance

Actions:

Copy the actions on the video and join in with the singing together.

Extension Activity:

What other verses can the children create? What other actions can they link to 'people who help us' and the jobs that they do? Can they think of some faster and slower verses and share them with the group?

Extension Activity:

Can the children count to 10 with their instrument, tapping or shaking the instrument whilst saying each number name?
